Jiangsu at a Glance

Jiangsu Province is located in the Yangtze delta area in the coastal region of eastern China. To the south-east, Jiangsu borders the city of Shanghai.

Foreign investment in Jiangsu, in actual use, reached US\$30.5 billion in 2022, a year-on-year increase of 5.7%, ranking first in the country.

Jiangsu saw a rapid growth in foreign investment in its manufacturing and high-tech industries, with year-on-year increases of 32% and 50.3%, respectively.

Highlights of the Trip

The 4D3N trip will bring you to two vibrant cities in Jiangsu:

1. Nanjing: South New Town and Jiangbei New Area

Industries: new materials, intelligent manufacturing, automobiles & rail, IC, life & health, digital economy, AI, green industries and modern service industries

2. Suzhou: Suzhou Industrial Park

Industries: information technology, high-end equipment manufacturing, biomedicine, nanotechnology applications, AI and modern services industries

South New Town in Nanjing

Focus: a first-tier business district with high-end commerce & trade headquarters economy, digital creativity and modern financial services

- Located in the southeast of downtown Nanjing
- Planned management area: 19.8 square kilometres, core area: 9.94 square kilometres
- Planned permanent population: 180,000
- Integrating the design of the ground and underground, and integrating the construction of subway and underground space, a public underground space with 129,000 square metres will be built
- To activate the use of historical buildings such as the main runway of the airport and the oil depot, cultural facilities such as museums and the Airport Runway Park, and office buildings near the airport runway axis and rail transit stations will be built, forming a central business and cultural district

Industries: new materials, intelligent manufacturing, automobiles & rail, IC, life & health, digital economy, AI, green industries and modern service industries

- Established with the State Council's approval in 2015
- Area: 788 square kilometres
- Strategic positioning of "Three zones and one platform":
 - 1. Independent innovation pilot area
 - 2. New urbanization demonstration zone
 - 3. Modern industrial agglomeration zone in Yangtze River Delta
 - 4. Important platform for opening up & cooperation in the Yangtze River Economic Belt

Suzhou Industrial Park (SIP)

Industries: information technology, high-end equipment manufacturing, biomedicine, nanotechnology applications, AI and modern services industries

- Established with the State Council's approval in 1994
- Area: 278 square kilometres, resident population: 1.23 million
- An iconic cooperation project between the governments of China and Singapore
- In 2022, the economic performance of SIP was record high:
 - 1. GDP: RMB351.6 billion
 - 2. Gross industrial output: RMB685.02 billion
 - 3. Total import & export: US\$107.79 billion
 - 4. Actual use of foreign capital: US\$2.09 billion
- 2489 national high-tech enterprises, 61 listed companies, and 180 unicorns and quasi-unicorns
- The only "provincial foreign-capital headquarters economic cluster zone" in Jiangsu Province
- Over 5000 global foreign investment projects (including 101 Fortune 500 enterprises investing in 166 projects)
- 1580 foreign high-end talents working in SIP (accounting for 20% of Jiangsu province)
- 37 institutions and 33 well-known universities
- Input of R&D: > 5% of GDP
